Budget questions I sent to Heidi:

- 1) Will we keep paying the insurance fee or could we set up a renter's insurance policy instead? From what I understand, before a few years ago, that was never in the library's budget and it came out of the city's general fund. - 2) Is the clerical expense category necessary? I'm not sure what that was used for or why the budget for it this year was almost \$900 according to the financial reports.
- 3) There are also a few other categories on the financial report that are listed as having a \$0 budget this year. Can we get rid of a few of those, or what are they listed for? (Example: Collections expense, Other professional services)

We will be removing the clerical fees this year.
